


- Each relationship must have a hand-drawn representation of each person; each relationship will be hand-lettered in the target language, complete with correct spelling, the correct article and a name
- The poster should be regular poster board sized, hand-drawn, may be colored or mono-chromatic.



My Family Tree



- Level 1 students should have 15 vocabulary words for the unit, and a picture for each word.
- Level 2 students should have 20 vocabulary words for the unit, and a picture for each word.
- Pictures may be hand drawn, magazine cutouts, or downloaded. Include an appropriate article, along with the word.
- Write on the back of poster: name, teacher, language and level
- In order to be judged, entries must be submitted according to these guidelines.

Guidelines

- A story (fairytale, invent a different ending for a fairytale, original story) consisting of 4 sentences per page – 5 pages minimum, using the imperfect and the preterite tense in Spanish. Must have a picture, drawing, clip art, or magazine cut out for each page. Must use vocabulary learned in school (not from internet/translator). If vocab is ABSOLUTELY necessary for story and student doesn't know it, they can look it up in the dictionary.
- Who is it geared to: Spanish 3 (Use of Imperfect & Preterite tense.
- Rubric: - Pictures: 1 per page
– Sentences: 4 per page minimum
– Grammar: No errors & Correct use of tenses
– Vocabulary: varied, well used, seen in class

MODERN MYTH

Guidelines

- Rewrite a myth or legend from **target culture** in English. All languages & levels.
- Myths must be 500-1200 words long. The entry must be typed, double-spaced, black ink, 12-point standard font (Arial, Times New Roman, or similar), single-sided with one-inch margins. The entry may be prose or poetry. The top of each page must feature the title, category number (see above), and page number. **Submissions must be accompanied by one cover sheet, and may be submitted either in print via courier or U.S. mail, or electronically.** The cover sheet must include the name of the student, school, teacher's name, grade in school, target language and level completed, the total number of words, the title of the myth, and the category (i.e., 1, 2 or 3 as identified above).
- Category 1: An original myth to explain the existence of some phenomenon in nature or modern culture. It should use Classical Greek or Roman mythological characters but not a combination of both; new, invented characters with classical names may also be used.
- Category 2: A classical myth in modern dress or setting that should be recognizable through the plot and not through the names of characters (the writer must identify the original myth in a postscript to the story).
- Category 3: A new myth using classical figures (may include minor original characters), e.g., a new Hercules tale
